## LOW BLOOD SUGAR (HYPOGLYCEMIA)

#### **SYMPTOMS**

- Feeling shaky
- · Being nervous or anxious
- · Sweating, chills and clamminess
- Irritability or impatience
- Confusion
- Fast heartbeat
- Feeling lightheaded or dizzy
- Hunger
- Nausea
- Colour draining from the skin (pallor)
- · Feeling sleepy
- · Feeling weak or having no energy
- Blurred/impaired vision
- Tingling or numbness in the lips, tongue or cheeks
- Headaches
- · Coordination problems, clumsiness
- Nightmares or crying out during sleep
- Seizures

If the person is showing <u>SYMPTOMS</u>, test BGL. Repeat test on the other hand to confirm level. If conscious and alert, give quick acting glucose immediately (15gm) then conduct test again. If still below TARGET RANGE, <u>DIAL</u> 000.

#### **ASYMPTOMATIC**

If they are **ASYMPTOMATIC**, conscious and alert, give quick acting glucose immediately (15gm)

- Half a glass of Lucozade/soft drink/cordial (non diet) or,
- 6-7 small jelly beans

Then test again in 15 minutes and if not improving repeat.

If signs of improving and if next meal not in 15-20 mins, give a slowly absorbed carbohydrate of either:

- Slice of grain bread (half a sandwich)
- · Large glass of plain milk
- Small glass of flavoured milk
- Small Glass of orange juice

# HIGH BLOOD SUGAR (HYPERGLYCEMIA)

#### **SYMPTOMS**

- Frequent urination
- Excessive thirst
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Dehydration
- Sleepiness
- Confusion
- Blurred vision
- Irritability

If blood sugar level is <u>OVER 14</u> on two readings 2 hours apart, notify Doctor.

### **ASYMPTOMATIC**

 If BGL is <u>OVER 20</u> and is <u>ASYMPTOMATIC</u>, re-test in 2 hours

If symptoms persists, DIAL 000 and notify Doctor.
